NO! When you saw the scratches, you immediately recognized them as a <u>deliberate act</u>. Why? Because order and design reveal intelligence and purpose.

# God, therefore, is undeniably seen in creation's order and design



From the creation of the world, God's invisible qualities...have been clearly observed in what he made. As a result, people have no excuse. Romans 1:20 (GNB)

Then you are not the debris of a "Big Bang", but the <u>special creation</u> of a loving and all-powerful GOD:

- 2. You do have eternal meaning and purpose!


#### God has spoken to man


This world is full of man-made religions that do not agree, and which are all based on the ideas of **men**. Let's face it, the only way we can know the truth about God, is if we hear it from God Himself. This is why we must never trust the ideas of men, but have a divinely inspired (God given) record for us to rely on.



# God has spoken to man

The Jewish Bible, (also known as the Torah, Tawrat, Old Testament. etc.) is the original book that claims God to be its author (to be divine).





The problem is, though all these religions claim to originate from the same *book* they do not all teach the same *thing*. So, how do we know what religion is *TRUE*? We know the truth by knowing God's <u>original</u> message to us <u>in the Old Testament</u>!

## The Key is to understand the Old Testament

Understanding the Old Testament is the key to knowing <u>the truth</u> about God, life, and death.



Let's look at 6 essential things it teaches:

**FIRST**: In the beginning, God created everything <u>good</u>. God made <u>one</u> man (Adam), from whom all people would descend. God loved man very much.

And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good. Genesis 1:31


**SECOND**: Adam foolishly rejected the authority of his loving Creator, choosing to do his *own* will instead of *God's*. In response to Adam's rebellion (sin), God cursed the ground from which Adam was made, which brought death to Adam. *The ground is cursed for your sake...dust you are, and to dust you shall return*. Genesis 3:17-19 (MKVJ)


And, now, we ALL die, because we all (like Adam) sin as well. Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and <u>so death passed upon all men, for</u> <u>that all have sinned</u>: Rom 5:12

**THIRD:** God is <u>perfectly good</u> (holy), so He rejects all who come short of His good and perfect standard. God gave a law so we could know what was good and right. Among many things, the law taught us the need to:

- 1. Never put anything before God.
- 2. Worship God and God alone.
- **3.** Love and serve God, and never dishonor His name.
- 4. Honor God as the Creator of all things and the giver of life.
- 5. Obey and honor the parents God gave us.

- 6. Never harm anyone in any way.
- 7. Be sexually pure and faithful to our spouse.
- 8. Never steal anything.
- 9. Always tell the truth.
- **10.** Be thankful for what we have, and do not envy.






**SIXTH**: In spite of our sin, <u>God still loved us</u>, so He promised to do something wonderful: He promised He would one day send a "Savior", who would take away our <u>sin</u>, <u>overcome our *death*</u>, and <u>make us acceptable to God</u>!

Speaking of this Savior, the Old Testament prophesied... You will again have compassion on us. You will <u>overcome our</u> <u>wrongdoing</u>. <u>You will throw all</u> <u>our sins into the deep sea</u>.


Micah 7:19

In 712 BC, the Old Testament said this loving Savior would take away our sins, <u>by taking our sins</u> upon **Himself** and <u>bearing the penalty of our sin in **our** place</u>.

...the LORD has laid <u>all our sins</u> on <u>him</u>. Isaiah 53:6



Although this wonderful Savior would die for our sins, He Himself would be **innocent.** God said the Savior would <u>fully **obey**</u> God's **law**, yet fully **endure** its **penalty** on our behalf.



Although he is innocent, he will take the punishment for the sins of others, so that many of them will no longer be guilty. Isaiah 53:11 CEV

Until that special day came, when the people's sins would be laid on the promised Savior, God instructed His people to <u>lay their sins on</u> innocent **animals** instead.




He shall put both of his hands on the goat's head and confess over it all the evils, sins...of the people of Israel, and <u>so transfer them</u> to the goat's head. Leviticus 16:21 GNB

Having their sins <u>symbolically</u> placed on the innocent animals, those **animals** (e.g. sheep, goats) were condemned to death (sacrificed), and <u>they bled</u> <u>and died in the sinners'</u> <u>place</u>.




...the life of the flesh is in its <u>blood</u>; and I have given it to you on the altar <u>to take away your sin</u>... Leviticus 17:11 BBE

In return, God accepted the "innocence" of these animals as a **covering** (atonement) for the guilty people. Because of this atonement (covering) God could look at these *guilty* people and see <u>innocence</u>.



...it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for

him. Leviticus 1:4



But who could this Savior be?

What man could <u>fully obey</u> <u>God's law</u>?

And who could love us enough to bear our sin and die in our place?

**GOD** could! Yes, the eternal God would be born as a man, so He could <u>live a *sinless* life</u> on our behalf, and then **die** as a *sinner* in our place! For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is aiven: and the aovernment shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6

At the close of the Old Testament (430 BC), God told His people that, before the promised Savior came, He would first send <u>a special messenger</u> to prepare the people and get them ready for His coming to earth.

Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: Malachi 3:1

And then...the people waited for the Savior (and His special messenger) to come.

# AND THE SAVIOR CAME!

400 years later, the Savior was miraculously conceived in a virgin named Mary. His birth was announced to the world and documented for us in the New Testament.

#### And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name <u>JESUS</u>: <u>for he shall save his people from their sins</u>. (Matthew 1:21)

And the angel said unto them...I bring you good tidings of great joy...For <u>unto you is born</u> this day in the city of David a <u>Savior</u>, <u>which is Christ the Lord</u>. (Luke 2:10-11)

## The Special Messenger – John the Baptist

John the Baptist (the special messenger) came immediately before Jesus to warn of God's future judgment on sin, and to tell all who wanted God's forgiveness that the Savior was coming soon.

John explained that the animal sacrifices in the Old Testament were only a *picture* of <u>the Savior</u>, who, like a *sacrificed lamb*, <u>would</u> be the **true** atonement for sin.

The next day John sees <u>Jesus</u>... and says, "Behold the <u>Lamb of</u> <u>God, which takes away the sin</u> of the world!" John 1:29

## Why Old & New Testaments?

A "Testament" gives something away <u>when someone</u> <u>dies</u>. That's why, when we make out a will, we say:

"This is my last will and testament."

<u>OLD TESTAMENT</u>: Forgiveness *charged* by the <u>animals</u>' death. *...for it is the <u>blood</u> that makes an atonement for the soul.* Leviticus 17:11

<u>NEW TESTAMENT</u>: Forgiveness *paid in full* by <u>Jesus</u>' death. Jesus described this as, "*...the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.*" Luke 22:20

# JESUS – OUR GREAT SUBSTITUTE

Jesus was <u>born</u> as our <u>substitute</u>. The lives of *animals* could not substitute for *men*, but JESUS, **as a man**, <u>lived</u> to fully obey God's commands on <u>our behalf</u>.

The Bible says Jesus "...was <u>in all points</u> tempted like as we are, <u>yet without sin</u>." Hebrews 4:15

JESUS DID THIS...

So you could get credit for HIS life!

# JESUS – OUR GREAT SUBSTITUTE

Then Jesus <u>died</u> as <u>our substitute</u>. The death of those *animals* could not pay the penalty for *men*, but JESUS, **as a man**, <u>died to pay the penalty of sin</u> on <u>**our** behalf</u>.

The Bible says God loved us so much that "...while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

#### JESUS DID THIS...

So you could get credit for HIS death!


# JESUS – REJECTED AND CONDEMNED

Though many believed and accepted Jesus, the majority of people rejected Him and condemned Him to death by Roman crucifixion.

And he <u>bearing his cross</u> went forth into a place called the place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha: <u>Where they crucified him</u>. John 19:17-18

This rejection of Jesus was foretold in the Old Testament:

He is despised and rejected of men... Isaiah 53:3



# JESUS – CRUCIFIED ON THE CROSS

The **Cross** is the focal point of our salvation, because <u>Jesus' death</u> on the Cross fully balanced the scale.



By dying for us on the Cross, Jesus fulfilled every demand of the law: He <u>paid</u> the law's <u>penalty</u> – **death**, and He <u>obeyed</u> the law's greatest <u>commands</u> – "**You** *shall love the Lord your God with all your heart...and your neighbor as yourself.*" Luke 10:27

# JESUS – BURIED AND RAISED AGAIN

After Jesus died, He too was buried (like one of us). But, on the third day, **Jesus rose from the dead** to conquer death on our behalf and give us hope beyond the grave!

"He is not here,



but is risen... (Luke 24:6)

*...the trumpet shall sound, and <u>the dead shall be raised</u> <i>incorruptible, and we shall be changed.* 1 Corinthians 15:52


# JESUS – COMING AGAIN

Jesus will one day come again <u>to judge the world</u>, and God now calls for all people to prepare for that judgment, by turning their hearts toward God and receiving Jesus. The Bible says God


...now commands all men everywhere to repent: Because he has appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he has ordained; whereof he has given assurance unto all men, in that he has raised him from the dead. Acts 17:30-31


# WORLD RELIGIONS

All world religions have <u>one</u> thing in common: In one form or another, they all put **YOU** on the scale:



But the **Gospel** (Good News) is: <u>the Cross</u> has made a way for us to be accepted by God <u>on the</u> <u>merit of His Son</u> – JESUS!





#### JESUS' SALVATION IS A FREE GIFT

The Salvation Jesus accomplished for you is a free gift.

...the wages of sin is death, but the <u>gift of God</u> is eternal life <u>through Jesus Christ our Lord</u>. Romans 6:23

You cannot *work* to <u>obtain</u> God's gift; and you cannot *work* to <u>keep</u> it. The Cross was **Jesus**' work, <u>not yours</u>.

For by grace you are saved through faith, and <u>that not</u> <u>of yourselves</u>, it is the <u>gift</u> of God, <u>not of works</u>, lest anyone should boast. Ephesians 2:8-9

# WILL YOU RECEIVE GOD'S GIFT?

God has given JESUS so your <u>sins</u> can be **forgiven**, and your <u>relationship</u> with Him can be **restored**.

Will you believe this good news and accept JESUS as <u>your</u> Lord and Savior today? Will you acknowledge your sin, and believe (trust) in JESUS' work for you on the Cross, so you may be judged on <u>the merit of Jesus</u> (God's Son)? The Bible says...

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever <u>believes in him</u> should <u>not</u> <u>perish, but have everlasting life</u>. John 3:16

### WHAT IF I REJECT JESUS?

Very simple, if you reject **Jesus**, God will reject **you**. You will die in your sin and spend eternity in the Lake of Fire.

On the Day of Judgment, the Bible says Jesus

...shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and <u>those who do iniquity</u>; And shall cast them into <u>a furnace of fire</u>: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. Matthew 13:41-42

## THE CHOICE IS CLEAR

All who rely upon JESUS will be saved from God's eternal judgment of sin, but those who do not trust Him as their Savior will be damned.

He who <u>believes on Him</u> is <u>not</u> condemned, but he who <u>believes not</u> is <u>condemned</u> already, because he has not believed in the name of the only-begotten Son of God... John 3:18

## WHAT IS YOUR DECISION?

Your sins now separate you from God, but God loves you my friend. Jesus gave His life for you. And, even if your sins be so big they reach as high as Heaven itself, God now stands with His arms outstretched toward you, ready to *forgive* you...ready to *receive* you, if you are ready to receive His Son.

Will you receive Him now?

How shall we escape, if we neglect such a great salvation? Hebrews 2:3
